
Paintings now hang in many public and private collections all over the world.































MARSAL









VILLA SALINARA

Historic charming villa in Western Sicily.

It was originally built in the 1700s. It is a rural farm, a "baglio", a "masseria", a typical Sicilian building with a courtyard in the front and rooms that open up on it. Surrounded by vineyards and olive groves located about 500 meters from the sea,

with Mediterranean sunset view.

Immersed in history and culture, close to many interesting sights as Mozia, Marsala, Trapani, Erice, Segesta and Selinunte. It is a place of indisputable charm.







ONE WEEK PROGRAM (7 NIGHTS, 8 DAYS)

- Spectacular subject matter at the Villa and within walking distance such as Windmills and Salt Pans in a Natural Preserve.
- Sea front at San Teodoro Tower and its surroundings.
- Historic Center of Marsala and Fish Market.
- Erice Mountain and the medieval village: An utterly panoramic ride with stops for beautiful sea views will take us to the medieval village.
- Grotta in Nature Preserve, then afternoon painting (and swimming) at the Beach at Monte Cofano east side.
- shopping trip to Marsala plus a visit to a local ceramist
- Wine tasting, a passionate sommelier will introduce the history of Marsala wines, accompanied by delicious local cheese, salami, olives, dry tomatos followed by a delicious light dinner at Villa.

The course is conducted in English.

Please note the itinerary is an example. Visits will depend on location and are subject to change depending on the weather.

WORKSHOP INCLUDES

- Tuition
- Accommodation in double room
- Accommodation in single room with supplement
- All Sicilian Breakfasts, lunches and dinners
- Wine tasting
- All local transportation
- Pick-up at Palermo airport on the first day between 10am and 3pm. We organise precise pick-up times to fit in with our guests' flight arrivals times.
- Transfer to Palermo airport on the last day after breakfast. Leaving around 9.30 am, but precise timing does depend on all our guests' flight times.

- Transfers to the villa from Palermo airport later than 1pm are extra, at cost.

WHERE YOU STAY

You stay in authentic decorated bedrooms in a complex of charming Sicilian villa.

All the rooms exude a Mediterranean atmosphere, a journey through the sensations and colours of Sicily. The interior has been restored with local natural materials, and is furnished in traditional Sicilian country style, with items that show total respect for its history and background.

There is a large communal sitting space in "Emporium of Grapes" for leisurely breakfasts and evening meals. There are facilities for personal cooking each accommodation.

WHAT IT COSTS

If you are coming on your own, you will have your own individual bedroom or independent accommodation.

If you share with other participant, each of you will save 250 euro.


